



HOW TO PACK A SHOEBOX

The shoebox you pack will show a child in need that it is loved and precious – to God and people.

1.

Start with a shoebox of an average-size (30 x 20 x 10 cm) and **DECORATE IT** with wrapping paper. Alternatively order our preprinted shoebox here: jetzt-mitpacken.de

2.

CHOOSE a „WOW-Gift“ that will astonish a child. Then fill your shoebox with other new items such as school supplies, clothes, candy (expires after March of next year), hygiene items, toys etc.

3.

We encourage you **TO PRAY** for the child that will receive your shoebox. You can also add a personal note and picture to your gift. **CLOSE YOUR GIFT** with a rubber band (do not tape it).

4.

Your donation is an investment into a child's life. To cover all costs we recommend a **DONATION OF 10 EUROS** per child. You can either give the money at your drop-off location, transfer it or use paypal.me/mitpacken.

5.

TAKE your shoebox to an official drop-off location by **November 15th**. After a quality check the boxes will be shipped to Eastern Europe and Central Asia.
